## LAY LEADERSHIP HAPPENINGS (Cont'd)

**Leadership Team report by Jerry Fogle, team chair:** In April, we approved the disaster relief trip proposed by Kenton Grossnickle, Wayne Grossnickle and Wayne Fisher. The LT approved reimbursing that team for any gas and meals requested by the team. The LT continued to wrestle with the task of replacing team members whose terms will be expiring in 2027 (16) and the following year (24). Alternative proposals are being considered.

In May, the LT decided to switch to a lesser expensive plan on the NBCBC website. They also decided to eliminate PayPal as the entity for collecting donations online. PayPal has made corporate decisions and have policies that are not biblically based or in line with NBCBC stated policy. Alternatives for donations will be considered.

The LT began looking at alternatives to replacing team positions of dozens of elected team members over the next couple of years. Changes to the constitution and position description documents will be considered.

In June, the LT approved the concept of removing term limits for team positions, and making changes in some teams and their responsibilities. This process is now under review and final decisions will be made at the July LT meeting, and possibly beyond.

The LT approved the concept of hiring a paid child care person for our worship services and possibly for Sunday school. Pastor Karen knows of some potential interested persons and a final decision will be made later.

The LT began discussions on the 2026 budget and approved a \$500 donation to the Blue Ridge district. They also began discussions with Pastor Karen regarding sabbatical possibilities in 2026 and beyond.

**Financial Management Team/Treasurer by Kevin Delauter:** The giving for 2025 as of 5/31/2025 is \$150 under the budgeted amount for the year. The FMT has renewed CD's and opened additional CD's for the church general and building funds. The current CD's are as follows:

25 month CD	\$32,000	General Fund
11 month CD	\$10,000	General Fund
25 month CD	\$80,000	<b>Building Fund</b>
25 month CD	\$78,000	Building Fund

The FMT appreciates the generous giving by our congregation to serve the needs of God's church.

**Communications by Cathy Hessong:** Nothing new to report but we would ask all to pass by word of mouth the date of our Fall Faith Festival 4 October 2025.

**Board of Trustees by Eddie Moser:** We haven't seen anything new or that would fit our church needs come on the market, though we continue to review listings as they are made available. We continue to monitor, inspect and assure that things that need repairs at the church facility are relayed to the elders to address.



A serious question to be considered very honestly by all who walk this earth. And particularly those who profess to be Christians. What do I mean "left behind?" Well, Matthew 24: 30-31 explains it better than I can:

"Then will appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven. And then all the peoples of the earth will mourn when they see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven, with power and great glory. And he will send his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other."


- Worship Service and Sunday School every Sunday
