Emergency & Safety Response Team by Jerry Fogle: Following three medical incidents in the first half of 2024, the ESRT reviewed the Incident Reports and decided on actions to improve response to emergency situations. The common thread to the three incidents was the refusal of the victims to seek medical attention. It was also realized that we did not have adequate "sugar containing" items when someone was low on blood sugar. The ESRT took the following actions:

- A "Refusal of Medical Services" form was developed and made available to the team;
- Various candy bars and other "sweets" were placed in the first aid box in the foyer at SDA church; and,
- Team agreement to call 911 when anyone falls, regardless of the victim's refusal to want EMS services.

The "Refusal of Medical Services" form is also stored in the first aid box in the foyer and a few copies are in the red notebook in the rear pew beside the sound booth at SDA. The ESRT will continue to monitor emergency situations and make improvements when necessary.

Worship Team by Bernie Tregoe: The worship team continues to refine and alter the order of service to best worship our God. The team is working on the Fall Faith Festival scheduled for October 12 at The Burkittsville Ruritan Club facility from 12:00 to 4:00pm. All teams of NBCBC will be involved in this outreach activity in order to make it a successful event. Mark your calendars to assist and attend!!

Financial Management Team by Tammy Fisher: We are trending well with the budget and will be working on the 2025 budget soon. , The Finance Team will need the Teams budget requests for 2025. We will be meeting on July 23rd to review and start planning next years budget.

Board of Trustees, by Eddie Moser: Coordination with SDA contact continues to go very well concerning use of the facility and maintenance and service issues encountered. We are so blessed to have such a great group of brothers and sisters in Christ to rent from and to have such a nice facility in which to worship. We continue reviewing all prospective properties identified to us by our realtor but nothing has surfaced yet that meets our needs and price point. Keep praying that God will provide the right place at the right time.

Leadership Team report by Jerry Fogle, team chair: In 2023, a sub-team appointed by the Leadership Team began updating and making needed changes to the "Constitution, Bylaws and Plan of Organization" and "Position Descriptions for Congregational Called and Elected Lay Ministry Positions" documents, both last updated in 2023 and 2022 respectively. That team presented proposed, updated documents to the Leadership Team in the fall of 2023. The Leadership Team reviewed the proposed changes, made additional proposed changes and returned the documents to the original team for review and finalization in April 2024.

The documents sub-team met several times, will meet in mid-July and will review the final proposed changes. They expect to present the documents to the Leadership Team in their August meeting. The Leadership Team will review, edit if needed and approve the proposed changes, likely in August or September. All of the documents will be published for review by the congregation and will be presented for approval at the November Congregational Business Meeting.

All of the proposed changes are needed to make our guiding documents reflect the current operations and direction of New Beginnings. Many people have put a lot of hard work and time into this effort and they have our respect and appreciation.

Gifts and Discernment by Darlene Moser: With some shifting in positions and personnel, the Gifts & Discernment team is once again back in action. One of those personnel changes was Virginia Lewis stepping down from the team due to personal reasons. We wish her well and pray she will return to service soon. We are prayerfully asking God to reveal through His Holy Spirit those folks to fill the vacant lay leader positions within the church. OR if you feel Him nudging you to get more involved in the work of the church, please contact me to explore what God is leading you to do. Remember, God will equip you if you answer His call. (Heb 13:21)

"Since I Have A Bible....." by Ed Moser In the '60s Peter, Paul & Mary sang a song titled "If I Had A Hammer". Part of the lyrics were: "If I had a hammer; I'd hammer in the morning; I'd hammer in the evening; All over this land. I'd hammer out danger; I'd hammer out a warning; I'd hammer out love between my brothers and my sisters

All over this land." May I propose that "Since I Have A Bible" I will read it in the morning, I read it in the evening all over this land. It warns of danger and warnings as well as admonishing us to love our brothers and sisters all over this land. God's word is very specific in telling us that we must read His word daily so that we may gain knowledge, wisdom, peace, help, hope and instructions for our daily lives as evidenced below:

John 1:1 ESV In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

Romans 15:4 ESV For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope.

Children's Church & Vacation Bilble School by Wendy Drum Our children have been active and learning text truths from the Spring and Summer "Explore the Bible" curriculum.
